From the above table, it can be concluded that **Pulsatilla** is the most frequently repeated remedy in anxiety 1<sup>st</sup> grade symptoms. The other closer remedies are **Phosphorous**, **Borax** and **Spongia**. Polycrest deep acting remedies like Cuprum, Sulphur, Sepia, Arsenic etc. come next in line. Thus, anxiety, a rising disorder of psychiatry is very well covered under the homoeopathic medicines and its symptoms can be managed holistically using the gentle homoeopathic approach.
